Design, development, and content teams all contribute to accessibility

#### **EXAMPLE SCENARIO:**

Your organization wants to launch a podcast series and have a customized audio player on your site.



#### Design

Include accessibility features in the design and user stories

# Ensure sufficient color contrast

#### Provide visible focus states

#### **EXAMPLE SCENARIO:**

Your organization wants to launch a podcast series and have a customized audio player on your site.



#### Development

Write valid, semantic code where all UI controls are correctly labeled with names, roles, and values

Provide logical keyboard navigation with no "keyboard traps"

#### **EXAMPLE SCENARIO:**

Your organization wants to launch a podcast series and have a customized audio player on your site.



#### Content

Provide complete, accurate transcripts for all episodes
